


There are steps and a ramp to get into the museum








Come and look inside!







A friendly member of staff will welcome you. They'll be wearing a lanyard








There are six galleries, two have permanent exhibitions on display. This photo is of the Victorian Gallery








This our Victorian Street. It is called Lark Hill Place








You can wear headphones to make the museum quieter. Alternatively, if you need a quiet space ask a member of staff and they will help you.








There is a lift








There is a café







There are toilets. They are along the corridor where the lift is









If you need assistance there are members of staff in the building who are here to help you








Some of our galleries have different temperatures and smells. If you need a quiet space, please ask a member of staff
