

Access

We would like everyone who visits Salford Museum and Art Gallery to feel welcome and easily able to move around the museum enjoying our collections, events and amenities.

Our service exists to collect and preserve Salford's Heritage including its Museums, artefacts, memories, documents, books, maps, memorabilia relating to the city's unique past and to make them available for all ages to learn from and enjoy through exhibitions, events, education and outreach. The service is part of Salford Community Leisure which is run by and for the people of Salford. Salford Community Leisure are committed to enhancing the physical and cultural wellbeing of the community through the sport, library and cultural opportunities offered across 40 venues, which attract millions of customer visits each year. We work hard to ensure each and every experience is the very best it can be.

Physical access

There are three accessible parking spaces for Blue Badge holders directly outside the museum to the right of the main entrance. There is a ramp to the left of the main entrance.

The gallery is accessible for wheelchairs and buggies though the internal doors are quite heavy. Please ask if you need assistance. There is a lift and accessible toilet with baby changing facilities on the ground floor, not far from the reception desk. There is also a baby change located in the ladies toilets.

Unaccompanied Children

Children under 8 years old must be accompanied by someone who is 16 or over and who is responsible for them during their visit.

Access for blind and partially sighted visitors

Guide dogs are welcome.

Access for deaf and hard of hearing visitors

Hearing dogs are welcome.

Autism Awareness
