Community Cases



Who are they for:

Community groups, associations, organisations, charities, schools, artists etc. based in and around Salford.

What are they for:

Showcase artwork created by and about the communities of Salford.

Why:

Provide a space to:

- Promote and showcase creativity in Salford
- Promote and celebrate communities
- Respond to local and national initiatives
- Provide an engaging, inspiring and high-quality display for gallery and café visitors

Where:

Three lockable glass cases in the café at Salford Museum and Art Gallery. The display area in each case measures approx. 118cm wide x 133cm high x 37cm deep. There are 6 movable glass shelves.

When:

Between mid-February and mid-August each year. Slots will be **at least 6 weeks** in length, dependent on demand and staff capacity.

How:

Please send an email to <u>exhibitions@scll.co.uk</u> stating a brief outline of what you would like to display, which communities are involved, and what the work is about.

Please also include:

- number of pieces
- sizes of pieces
- when you might like to use the cases, ie: whether it is to celebrate a special date
- images of the work

Proposals will be taken and reviewed on an ongoing basis by the exhibitions team. They will be looking for displays that are engaging, inspiring and high quality.

Please note:

- Cases will be installed by gallery staff, and at the moment there is no way of fixing into the case backing. The gallery can provide stands to prop works up if needed.
- There is no budget to pay for preparation of the pieces, so artwork will need to be ready for display.
- The gallery will create a text panel to explain the project and artwork to visitors using information provided by the artist/group.
- The gallery will promote the display on its website and social media as appropriate.
- The gallery reserves the right to refuse items unsuitable for display.
- The gallery will not insure any of the works and cannot be held liable for any loss or damage to work however caused.
- The artist/group will deliver and collect works on agreed dates. Anything left on the premises after the agreed collection date will be disposed of.
